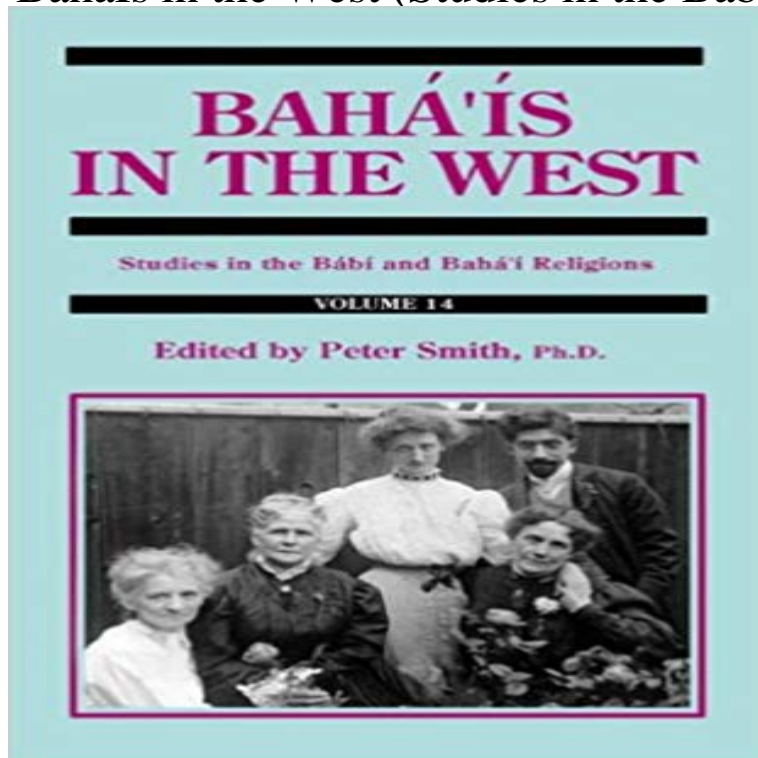

Peter Smith provides a masterful summary of the development of the Bahai Faith in the Western world. This is the most complete survey of Bahai growth and development that has yet been attempted. Moojan Momen shares his discovery of an unpublished manuscript by John Esslemont, who surveyed the Bahai world in 1919. The contrast is stunning. Gyorgy Lederer provides new information on Abdul-Bahas visit to Budapest in 1913. An essay by Jackson Armstrong-Ingram uncovers the odd events which transpired at the National Bahai Convention in the United States in 1910.
