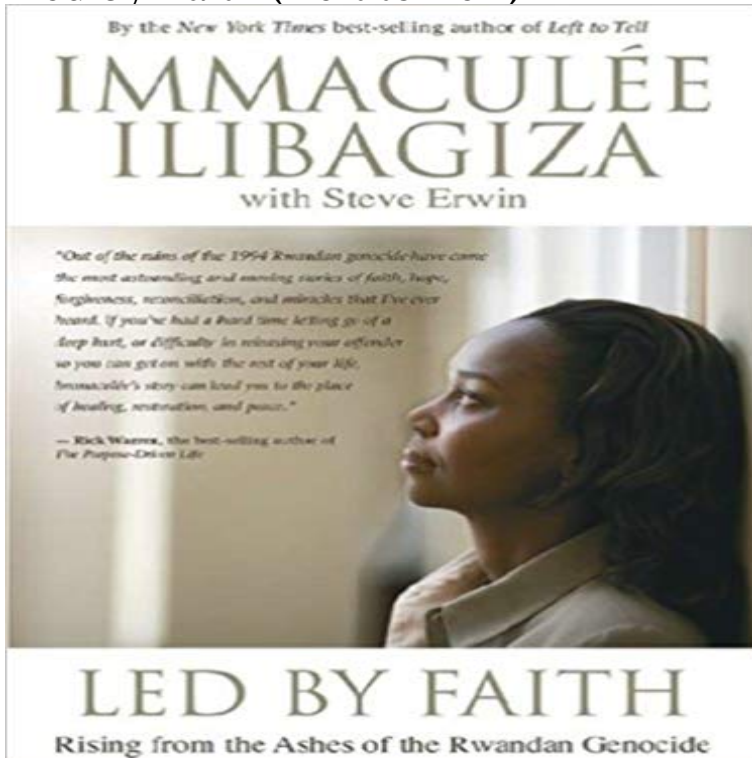


Led by Faith (Left to Tell)
