


Party in the Blitz

Eliot, Iris Murdoch, Wittgenstein, Herbert Read, Bertrand Russell—Canetti rakes them all over the coals. To Canetti, T.S. Eliot was nothing more than an American emigrant trying desperately to act British, and Canetti's portrayal of Iris Murdoch, with whom he had an affair, is nothing short of brutal. Michael Hofmann's translation pulls no punches, delivering the goods on Canetti's searing injection: when you write down your life, every page should contain something no one has ever heard about.
