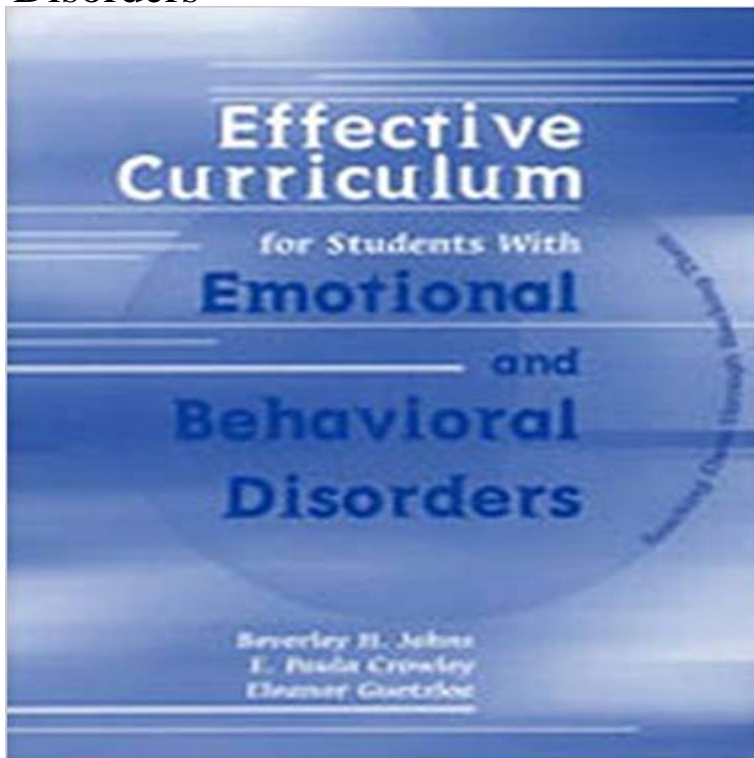


Effective Curriculum for Students with Emotional and Behavioral Disorders
