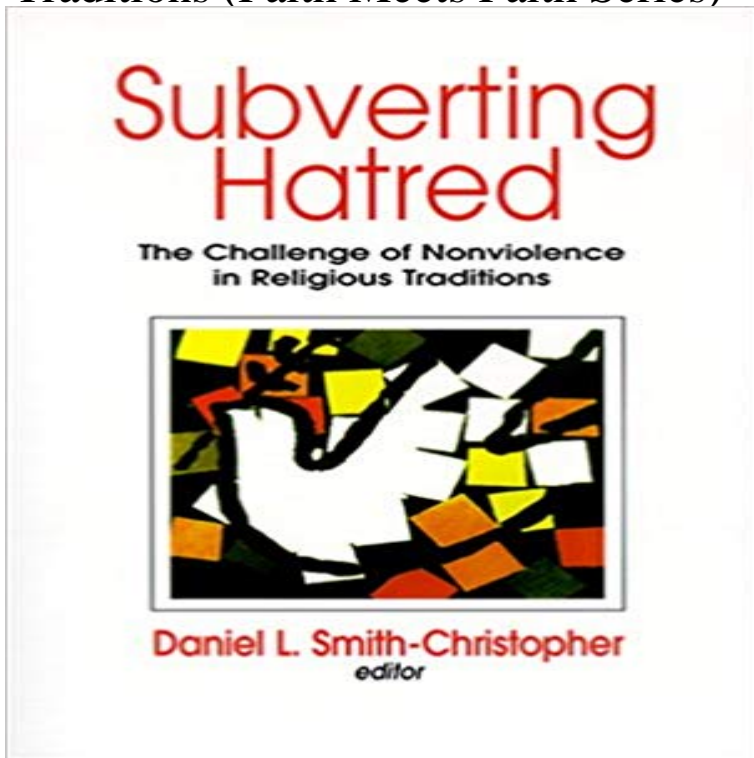


Subverting Hatred: The Challenge of Nonviolence in Religious Traditions (Faith Meets Faith Series)
