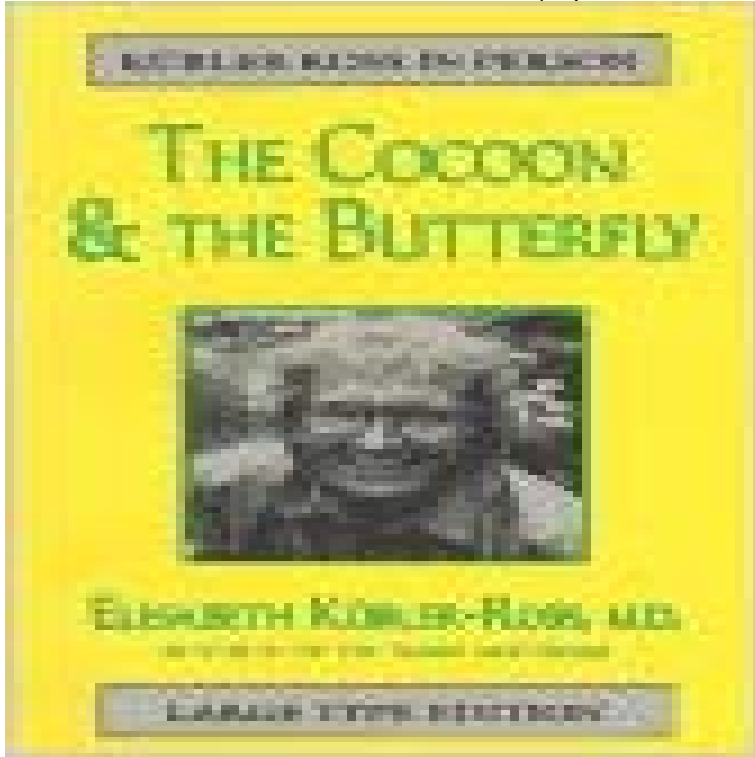


The Cocoon & the Butterfly (Kbler-Ross in Person)
