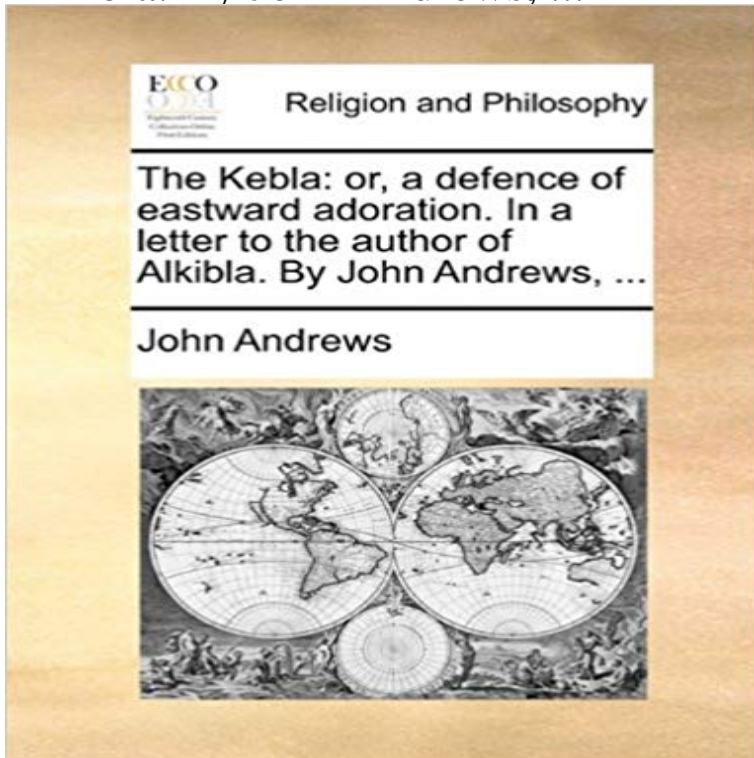


# The Kebla: or, a defence of eastward adoration. In a letter to the author of Alkibla. By John Andrews, ...
